The self-guided walking home tour is from 10:00AM to 5:00PM. Homes are docent-hosted. Oxnard's Carnegie Art Museum will be the beginning point of the tour – come and enjoy a fun-filled day with us as we step back into yesteryear.

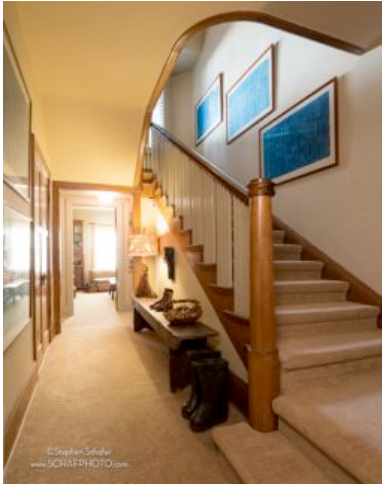
